#### **SCOPE and METHODOLOGICAL NOTE**

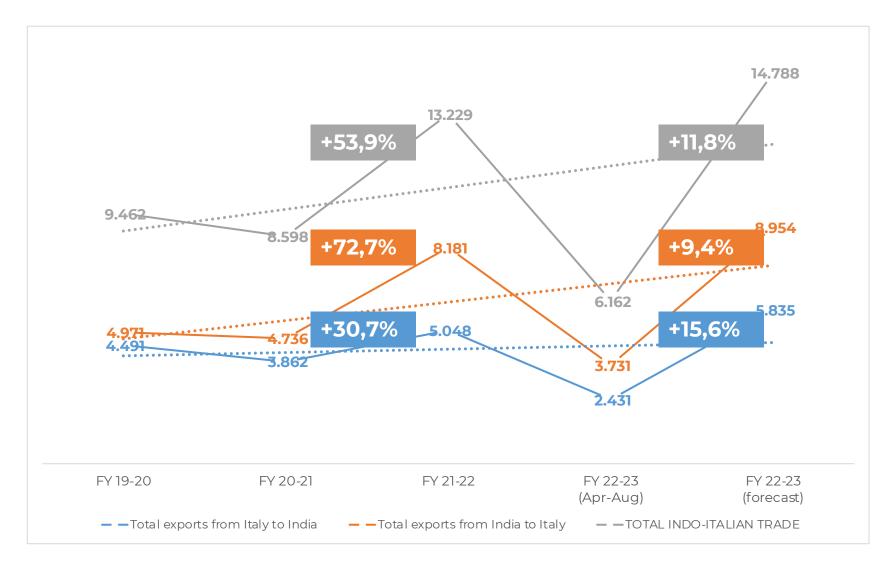
- The present slides intend to provide an as detailed as possible picture of the current state of affairs of Italian exports and investments into India.
- The information presented is statistical in nature, it is based on official data and their intepretation by the IICCI – Indo-Italian Chamber of Commerce and Industry.
- The main source of data for this analysis are the Indian Ministry of Commerce for trade statistics between Italy and India, the Reserve Bank of India for the Foreign Direct Investments and direct data collection and updation undertaken by the IICCI, with specific reference to the presence of Italian companies in India.



- The trade data is based on the Indian financial year (Apr to Mar), which explains some differences in the figures resulting from other sources based on the calendar year (Jan to Dec).
- ❖ The Indian system is based on the Harmonised System (HS) code, which focuses on the kind of products/commodities rather than their applications: the IICCI Indo-Italian Chamber of Commerce and Industry has re-worked such data keeping in mind the sectors and applications of relevance for this presentation.
- The trade statistics in this presentation cover exclusively Italian exports of goods: all the consulting, technical and other services (engineering, project planning, development, implementation) sourced by Indian companies to Italian suppliers have not been considered in the analysis.



#### INDO-ITALIAN TRADE – FY 2019 to FY 2023 (forecast)



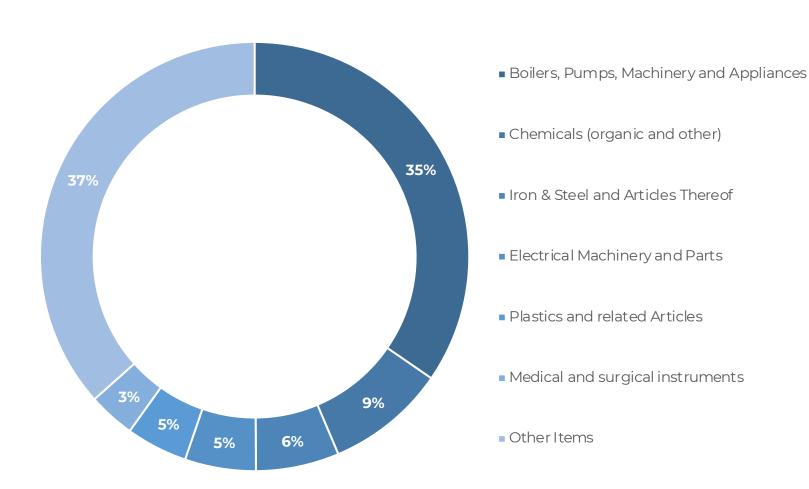

#### **MAIN TRENDS**

- Bilateral trade in steady increase:
   besides a contraction in FY 20-21, the
   average yearly growth rate of trade
   between FY 19-20 and 21-22 is +20%
- Balance of trade traditionally in favor of India: +480 mio US\$ in FY 19-20, +874 mio US\$ in FY 20-21, +3,132 mio US\$ in FY 21-22 and +3,119 mio US\$ in FY 22-23 (forecast), for a total surplus of ~7.6 billion US\$ in favour of India
- Turning point in FY 21-22: +54% of total bilateral trade, +73% of Indian exports to Italy and +30,7% of Italian exports to India. Driving factors:
  - shuffling of Italian companies' global supply chains
  - Hike in prices of commodities, semi-finished and finished materials
- Trend expected to be maintained in FY 22-23, with +12% increase in total bilateral trade, (+1,600 mio US\$), +9% of Indian exports to Italy (+773 mio US\$) and +16% of Italian exports to India (+786 mio US\$)

#### **KEY POINTS**

- The same global pattern of Italy's exports is present in India: the manufactuing sector (boilers, pumps, mechanical and electrical machinery with related components) represents the major item: their combined value is 40% of Italy's exports to India, for a total value in the period of ~5.6 billion US\$
- Organic and other chemicals rank 2nd in Italy's exports to India: 9% of total exports in the period worth ~1.5 billion US\$
- With exports worth +1 billion US\$ in the period, Iron & Steel and related articles rank 3rd in Italy's exports to India, 6% of the total: the main applications of the items are in the heavy industry, infra & construction, power and energy, automotive, machinery and manufacturing in general
- Medical and surgical instruments, consumer goods (furniture, textile & apparel, food&wine) count for the remained 37% of Italy's exports in the period

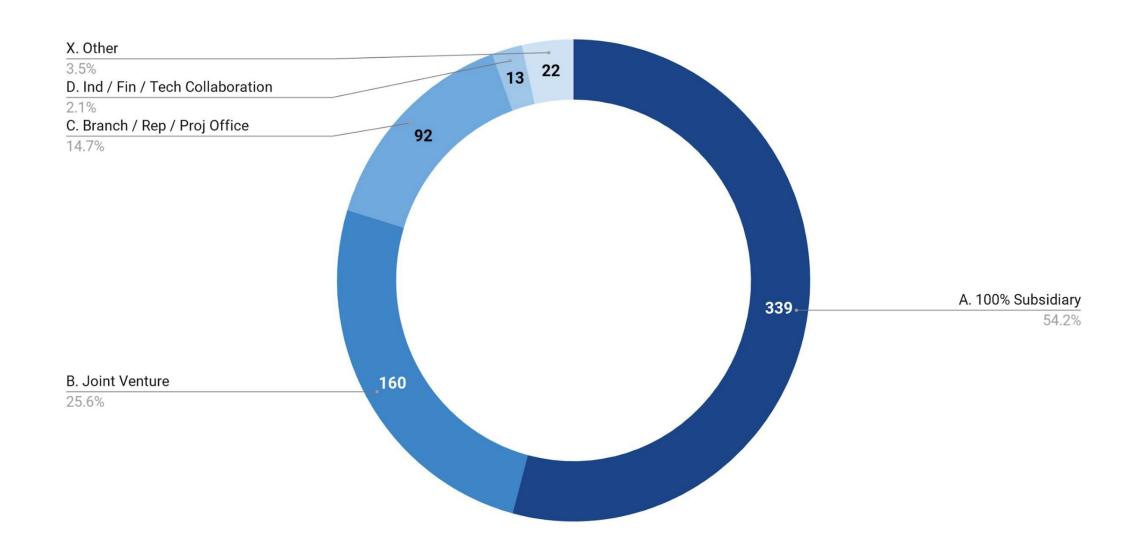

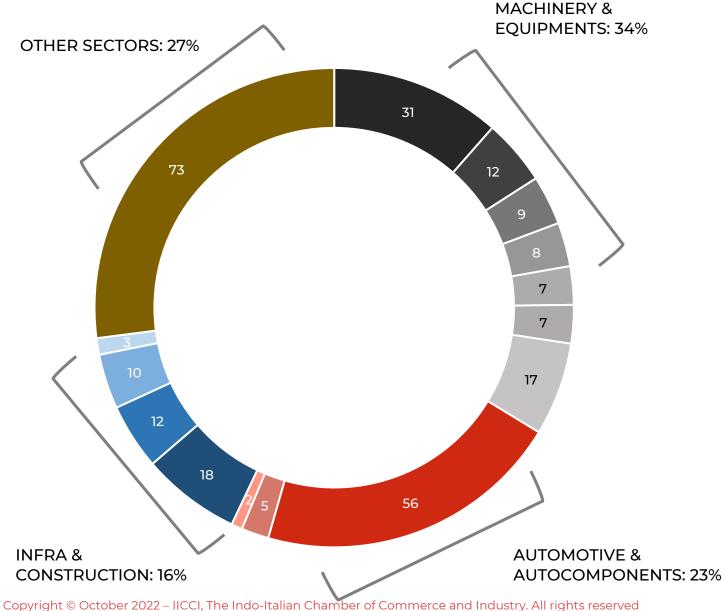


## **Italian Companies in India - Classification**





### **Italian Companies with Productive Plants in India - Sectors**



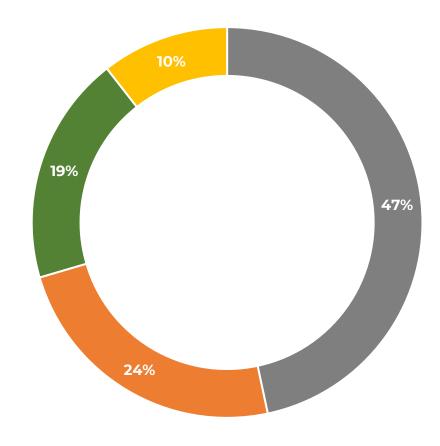

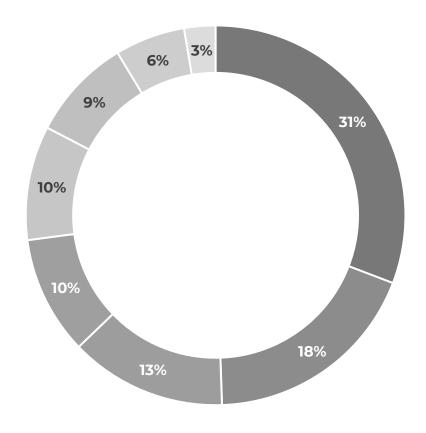

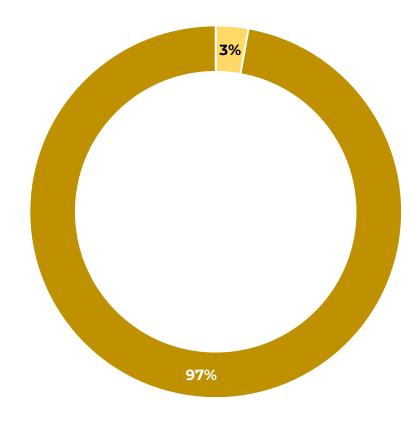
